

SUGARLAND RUN STREAM VALLEY TRAIL

is part of the countywide trail system. This trail runs from Sugarland Road to the Town of Herndon line. The distance along the main trail is approximately 3 miles. Side trails and connectors provide an additional 3 miles of trail. Some of the side trails are on homeowners association property and are maintained by the association. Other trail connections to Reston trails, the Fairfax County Parkway trail, and the trails through Runnymede Park in the Town of Herndon are provided as well. The trail is paved for its entire length. Stream crossings include bridges and fairweather crossings.

Access points for this section of trail are through neighborhoods along the trail as shown on the map – several of the access trails are fairly steep.

There is limited parking along the neighborhood streets and cul-de-sacs. There are no service facilities on this stretch of trail
